

HHS Logos for Placement



The HHS logo is for official use only. Approved uses include: printed materials (pamphlets, posters, flyers, booklets, periodicals, etc.), exhibits and other public affairs-related materials, HHS and Operating Division business cards, and PowerPoint presentations. The HHS logo is generally placed in the bottom, left-hand corner of ASPR materials.

The logo cannot be used in conjunction with any seals. It may also not be used by the private sector, including grantees, vendors, and contractors. (Contractors may use the HHS logo when producing ASPR materials as part of their contract work.) The logo cannot be used in combination with other elements to create a logo for an office or program.

Two-Color Reproduction: Two- or multi-color reproduction of the logo is not permitted.
